Pat Bennett Earns NASE's 2011 Achievement Award!!

Most of you know that Luratics and Wicked Coursing are two arms of the same organization – Luratics is the event side for all-breed lure coursing, and Wicked Coursing manufactures premier lure coursing equipment. Pat Bennett owns and operates both.

In June, the National Association for the Self Employed (NASE) chose Pat as their 2011 Achievement Award recipient for her innovative lure coursing equipment and her work with both Wicked Coursing and Luratics.

In January, Pat had received the NASE Growth Grant – a \$5,000 grant that helped Pat get Wicked Coursing's ZippityDog off the ground and produce the custom-designed drive pulley for the L'il Monster reversible machine (Luratics now has its own L'il Monster!).

The NASE grant committee was so impressed with Pat's business plan and her use of the Growth Grant proceeds that they chose her as the recipient for NASE's annual Achievement Award. This award includes ongoing hands-on business mentoring, tax counseling, national and local recognition, and an additional grant of \$20,000.

Pat recalls that when the NASE folks called, they only told her she'd won the Achievement
